Dates: 13-15 May 2022

Format: NZCF and FIDE rated 6 round Swiss, paired with Vega

Time Control: 90 minutes for the game plus 30 seconds per move added from move 1.

Venue: Canterbury Chess Club, Unit 9, 27 Tyne Street, Christchurch.

**Rating:** The tournament will be NZCF-rated and FIDE-rated. For the purposes of pairings and grade prizes, NZCF standard ratings will be used. Where players do not have a published NZCF rating, the Chief Arbiter may assign a rating at his discretion.

**Prizes**: Total prize fund of \$500 is guaranteed: 1<sup>st</sup> \$200, 2<sup>nd</sup> \$120, 3<sup>rd</sup> \$80, U2000 \$50, U1700 \$50. The highest-placed Cantabrian will be named the **All Canterbury Champion**. Please note that players may only win one cash prize – prizes will be shared between eligible players on the same score.

Entries close at 6:30pm. **Half-point Byes:** Players may take a half-point bye in any of the first four rounds (max 1 per player) – please advise when entering.

**Entry Details**: The entry fee is \$50 or \$40 for unwaged/retirees/students/juniors. Please note that NZ players who participate in two or more NZCF rated tournaments in a year are required to be a member of an NZCF Affiliate or Associate Chess Club. See www.newzealandchess.co.nz for further details on how to join a chess club. Foreign players must have a FIDE ID prior to entering. NZ players without a FIDE ID will be assigned one by FIDE (date of birth required).

**To enter:** email canterbury@chess.org.nz with your name, phone number, NZCF registration code and FIDE ID (NZ citizen/residents without a FIDE ID will be registered with FIDE by NZCF – please provide date of birth), and pay the entry fee by internet banking to: 03 0802 0093915 00 (please include your name and "Nijman" as a reference) or advise if paying cash at the tournament. If taking a half-point bye, please also advise in this email.
